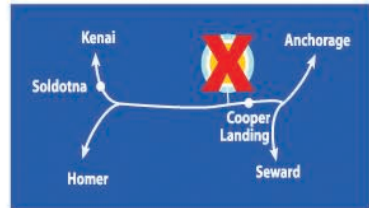
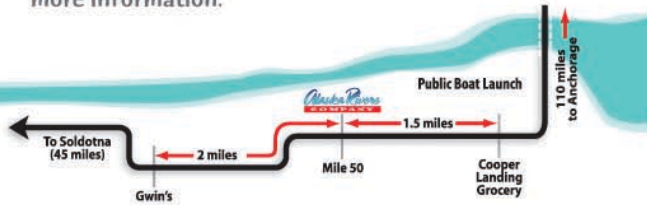
Kenai Canyon This exciting 7-hour adventure continues past "Jim's Landing" and the exhilarating rapids of the Kenai Canyon. Enjoy excellent wildlife viewing in the heart of the Kenai National Wildlife Refuge, a hearty Alaska lunch, and either a 5-mile boat ride across Skilak Lake or a 1.5-mile nature walk up Hidden Creek Trail, depending on weather conditions. Departs mornings daily. Suitable for all ages.
